

LGAA Monthly Meeting: April 12, 2017

1. **Treasurer's Report:** Betty reported that we started off with a beginning balance of \$2866.46. There were credits of \$90 for the Ballet door and \$122 for the Art sale, for a total of \$212. There were also debits for \$165.75 for Pizzas for the Tulsa Junior Ballet, \$92.50 for the rent of the upper elementary activity room and janitor service, \$137 for the LG Art class, and \$186 for the PSO deposit on the new building. Ad Sales totaled \$180. The balance going forward is \$2677.21. In other discussion, the Chamber is to pay back 1/2 of the PSO deposit on the building and a brass plaque has been ordered for the new building. It is 16"x8" and will be framed and put on the building. The cost is \$147.
2. **LGAA Newsletter Report:** Roxann reported that there was still a need for news from the town of things going on. Discussion was led into ways of obtaining more information. Marea was featured in the last newsletter. Betty sold ads while delivering papers. Betty and Theresa will be working together on this going forward.
3. **Scholarship nominations:** It was determined that the scholarship amount would be \$500. The motion was made by Shaun and 2nd by Kelly. The motion passed. The Nomination for this year was Sydney Schwichtenberg. It was discussed that even though this year that was done as a nomination, next year we should open it up to an application process.
4. **Approve/Reject hiring a news writer for school related arts news:** A discussion was led about who might be able to do such a task. It was suggest by Shaun that we ask Melissa if she wants to do it. It was tabled until a later meeting to find out if she is interested in doing it.
5. **Approve/Reject to hiring a summer arts director for summer camps:** This was tabled. Tara is looking into it. It has been done from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm as a creativity camp at the VFW. It was 4 weeks long, 4 days a week being Monday through Thursday. There was also discussion of laying some ground rules for the program that April has been in charge of.
6. **Getting people more involved with what we are trying to accomplish and report newsworthy items:** Discussion followed with some ideas floating around. Get the schools to write and give information, library activities, and word of mouth. The newsletter deadlines for the article information is around the 20th of each month.
7. **Founder's Day Art Show:** We have 25 signed up for the Art Show. Hours are from 10:00 to 3:00 with a Silent Auction or Silent Bid. David Fishinghawk will do the fire walk and the fire breaks again and there wil be other things such as a horseshoe tournament and a street dance going on. There was also some discussion on whether we have enough promotional information on hand to cover Founder's Day.
8. **ROMP News:** Shaun reported on the activities to come for the Wonder City WORDfest. To be held April 15th. She handed out fliers to everyone with all of the activities listed with the times of the events. Also have had a few visitors to the museum from out of state.
