Treasurer's Report: The report was not given at this time.

Instant Art Show Report: Entry deadline is October 7th. Roxann is hoping that everyone can enter. There has been lots of work on the building. There are Camera's available to use at Wonder City with the film costing \$1 a picture. Entry forms were handed out and available hand out to anyone interested. Basic information is on the back side of the entry forms that were handed out.

Proposals to sponsor and purchase materials for upcoming workshops:

- A. October 20th, Pam Quantie with Painting with Pam.** The evening was approved. Budget and all was set to be about the same as her last event.
- B. November 3rd, Sarah Coday card making.** Sarah said that she felt that \$30 to \$40 should cover the supplies but a budget of \$50 was approved. Motion to accept by Pam and seconded by Roxann
- C. Heather Davis Thanksgiving Painting.** Heather said that the budget of \$150 last time worked and it should be about the same this time. Pam motioned to make \$150 the budget, seconded by Kelly the date is set for November 10th.

Discuss possible partnership with Creative Oklahoma as the fiscal agent in applying for a community/art center. Shaun led in the discussion stating that a partnership could increase our chances to receive a grant for a community/art center. She has applied for a grant from Loiver Mayor last year and the internet shows that it is still setting there. She has sent an email to find more information on that situation. She has also set up an online link for memberships and to pay using Paypal. It would be better if that was also linked to the bank account for easier transferring of funds. Once Betty has been given information on this, it will be linked. A donation button will be added as well.

ROMP news. Rummage store is moving to the north side of Main Street in the old bakery building. The date of the move is still unknown. ROMP will be doing something with the Comic Con in January. LGAA should also get involved. Tables need to be reserved.

Open Discussion Ceiling tiles offered to all of those who had not already gotten one.

Dwight is doing jewelry pieces from silver and turquoise. Can't get ahead enough on the number of pieces to do a show. Linda is painting on multi-media and fused glass on canvas. She has a show at The Artarty in Tulsa coming up. Ray has finished a painting.
