

**LGAA Monthly Meeting: August 9, 2017**

**Treasurer's Report:** Report given by Betty. There was a few things that were given that were from July and then carried over for August. There was a beginning balance of 3333.11 on the printed report. From that there were payments of \$671.10 to Cowan's Insurance, \$66.60 to LG PWA, and a Plumbing charge on the office of \$52.50 that was paid to the Chamber giving a balance to start August report with \$2422.30. From that point, there were credits from the Chamber for 1/2 of the insurance and utilities for \$368.85, A donation from Bob Taylor for \$1313.06, A donation of \$200 from The package Store, Ad sales total of \$879.00, and a membership from Sarah Coday for \$20.00. Other debits were to Pam Quantie for reimbursement for workshop supplies and the chili contest of \$152.61, PSO service of \$40.12, the Gallery Hanging system for \$1313.06, LG PWA for \$66.60, and another PSO service of \$48.97. This brought us to a balance of \$3914.40. Motion was made to accept the report by pam and was seconded by Roxann. All approved.

**Newsletter Report:** Shaun and Roxann are helping to write stories as well as Marea sending information from the public library to the newsletter. Kelly is printing and the timing of the printing was discussed. It may continue to come out around the first part of the month. Kelly mentioned that as long as it is not to be printed on the first or the second of the month it should be fine. Bob Taylor was featured in this months issue. Wanda Keys is sharing stories each month. Sydnie is possibly going to start to write a column from the viewpoint of a freshman at a big University. Sarah Coday will be helping with the Art show. The Senior Citizens Center have been sending information in for the issue. Heather Davis will be doing a craft painting workshop of a Pirate Megaphone on August 25th.

The motion was made and seconded to pay for the supplies for the workshop up to \$200. All agreed.

**The Painting with Pam event:** The event was a big success. 42 were signed up for the event with 40 that were present for it. Everyone enjoyed it.

**Discussion of another event:** After discussion, it was decided that there will be another painting event by Pam on October 20th starting at 5:30 pm. The LGAA will sponsor the event with a budget of \$200.

**Discussion of phone service for the new building:** After some discussion, it was decided that this should be tabled until a later date. With the building still being worked on, it was a too early to decide for sure if phone service will be needed. To be revisited at a later date.

**Building improvements:** The building is in need of some improvements to the bathroom, storage, and the back door. Jerry has been working on this and the estimated cost for the supplies to make these improvements is \$200. The motion to accept the expense of the supplies set at \$200 was made by Theresa and was seconded by Pam. All agreed.

**In An Instant Photo Art Show:** The gallery hanging system is being installed by Jerry. The event has been widely advertised with 2 ads that need to be reimbursed to Roxann for an approximate cost of \$204. Kelly made a motion and it was seconded to reimburse the money spent on the advertisements. All agreed.

**Update for teacher's luncheon:** The teachers were very appreciative of the information and door prizes. Jennifer reported that she had a conversation with Lori Helton about the LGAA being available to help out with some needs as well as getting information from them about what is going on with the school. She also was told about the Makerspace being a Steampunk Art theme at this point. Mid-America Industrial Park has been instrumental for starting this as a way of giving hands on experience to those who are interested in going into manufacturing. Also was some discussion about being watchful for someone to take on the Children's program. Someone that has a passion for that type of thing.

**Fundraisers:** Discussion of the possibilities of getting some of the Instant type cameras and even possibly some film for people to use for the In an Instant Photo Art Show. There was some discussion about making it something that is connected to the photography class that Betty is doing on September 1st. If someone wanted to use it there to take their photos so that the cameras would also be available to others at the same time was an option discussed.

Ceiling tiles were handed out to members in attendance. These tiles are to be decorated to be hung in the new building. They can be painted or decorated in some other manner as long as it is still able to be hung. These tiles need to be completed and hung before the Art show on October 14th.

**ROMP:** No news from ROMP. However Shaun will be presenting the show **Poem Life** on August 19th at the Mayes County Cultural Art Center in Pryor at 6 N. Adair from 7:00 - 8:30 PM.
